

IA – **'fix it'**....
some suggestions!

What do these mean?

- **PS**: poor sentence. Best sentence is a 'short sentence- more precise and accurate.
- **PP**: poor paragraph. Shows poor planning and mixed up thinking
- **PA** : poor argument: argument is unclear and not easily understood
- **Paragraph Advice:**

1st :Sentence introduces key purpose/idea of paragraph

Main Body: argument clearly outlined/explained with clear connections with diagrams where relevant

Last: sentence: 'job done'. This sentence clearly summarises your point/argument and/or introduces next paragraph/idea

Some other abbreviations...

- **Ref:** references. Be sure to reference (footnote) all quotations and paraphrasing of the article
- **U:** unclear. What you have written is unclear / maybe due to a poor sentence.
- **C:** contradiction. This is where you have written opposing arguments. This looks poor in terms of your planning.

Criteria A:

Criteria A: (3 marks Diagrams+explanation):

- Title diagrams cleverly: use 'to show' in title as it highlights the exact usage of the diagram
- Underline all titles + use larger/bold font
 - How many diagrams? 2-3 probably!

Criteria B:

Criteria B: (2 marks Definitions):

- Define key terms 'expertly' maybe making a reference to the article
- Define as you use. Avoid giving a list of definitions in the first paragraph

Criteria C:

Criteria B: (2 marks application of theory to article):

- Make sure you are using the **appropriate + best theory** when building your link between the article and your commentary

Criteria D:

Criteria D: (3 marks: analysis):

- Quote
 - Expert use of diagrams
- Explain 'LINK' between article + theory

Criteria E:

Criteria E: (4 marks: evaluate):

- Quote
- 2 + perspectives e.g. stakeholders
 - Judgement
