EE Final Tips

EE Final Tips before submission:

1. Result:

- A, B, or C...or maybe a D? Use 619 to grade your work.
- If you consider your IA work here you will understand the need to analyse and evaluate your data carefully with arguments supported by evidence/data while recognizing some limitations of your research.

2. Diagrams:

- Check your diagrams carefully for theoretical errors and make sure that the diagrams relate clearly and exactly to your research question while using data from your research on your diagrams.
- The use of relevant titles (underlined and bolded) helps the reader to follow your use of the theory as you use it to understand the data e.g. data supports the need for government intervention in the market/ economy in order to compensate for weaknesses / delays/time lags that occur in the market/economy.

3. Answer + Limitations:

- Have you answered the RQ (question) in your conclusion. Probably not!
- Be sure to address the question carefully and consider reasons why your answer/findings/conclusions might be questionable and therefore additional research might be necessary.

4. Bibliography/references/appendix:

- One of the signs of a poor research essay is the scarcity of records of where you located your research.
- You will have used a range of books, newspapers, websites etc and you must let the reader know when and where you used these resources. Failure to do this will move you nearer to the 'D' grade range or worse.

- Drop up to Mr. Crouch with your final essay and ask him to look over your Bibliography/references/appendix. In relation to the appendix be sure to make a direct reference to the bulk data you have collected and placed in your appendix because you did not need the data in the main body of your essay.
- Let the reader know exactly which part of the appendix you are using in your essay. E.G appendix A, Table 2 etc
- Make sure your essay has page numbers. All sections are findable using the content pages and the page numbers.
