

## **How to structure your Newslog?**

Summary of article: (circa 100 words)

Note the main points/parts of the article. The objective here is to highlight the main theme or story in the article. You might also want to consider here:

- . Highlight the key problem in the article
- State why you chose this article/story
- Analysis: (circa 300 to 400 words) (Tip: Try and Link the article to any of the economic theory we have studied using diagrams and quotes.)
  - Focus on the diagram(s) that you used and make clear statements about the (in)effectiveness of the theory as represented by the diagrams. E.g. stakeholders or who was affected by the story in the article
  - The diagrams may also highlight one or two limitations!
  - Use quotations as evidence to build strong arguments. Make sure you use a vocabulary list to use some business/economic vocabulary.
- 3. Evaluation: (circa 200 words) (Tip: Try and Link the article to any of the economic theory we have studied using diagrams and quotes.)
- 4. Suggestions: be sure to use economic evaluative diagrams + language to make a comment on the article or part(s) of the article
  - Consider the story in the article. Is the action justified?
  - Does the action (of government/firm/consumer) work?
  - Is the argument in the article biased or one sided?
  - How is the government/country affected by the story in this article?
  - Does the action reported in the article work?
  - Yes or no or partly? Why? because....
  - Limitations... does the article present a solution to the problem /issue.
  - Are there stakeholders ( stakeholders are interested groups like consumers or firms) that benefit or lose in the story/article?
