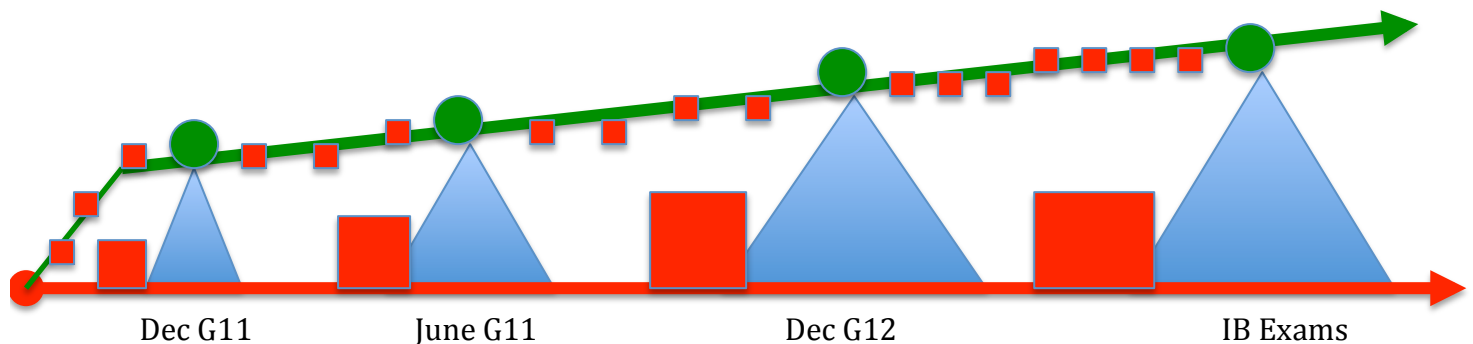


IB Study SKILLS: REVIEW- 2 systems for reviewing content



▲ = CONTENT for revision ■ = REVIEW content before exams
(Review Strategy: 1 hour per subject per week) ● = My Best Performance

▲ = REVIEW LINE: Question Based Learning + Review System (1 subject-1 hour-per day)
■ = Revision: "last minute.com" (try to cram all that content in!)

Solution:

1 subject per day for 1 hour

How do you review? Follow the simple steps below.

1. Select a section of the syllabus to review
2. Take an A3 paper and select 2-3 IBO questions from the shared folder taking note of where you will find the markscheme.
3. Using 5-8 minutes plan in blue ink the answer to the exam question. Make an answer plan that records what you can remember in relation to the question. Draw the diagram(s), briefly define and make a P1, P2, P3 paragraph plan.
4. After some minutes you should have a good idea of your level of answerability. Remember you have only used your memory thus far.
5. Now go to IBO markscheme on the submariner shared folder. Check the markscheme carefully and identify items you left out, did not remember etc
6. Now use your notes/index cards/ book etc to make some suggestions + improvement and correct any errors.
7. If you can identify the information that you forgot and did not know then you are immediately improving your answerability and the transfer of this information into your long term memory is underway.
8. Repeat this process for another question.
9. Come back next week for another hour for a different syllabus sections and keep on repeating the cycle one hour per week ... and see what happens over time.
10. You must be resilient and stick with the process or you will have to review the whole syllabus prior to the IBO exams.
