Task: For each question you select do the following 1-5:

1. **Box A:** Select your Question.
2. **Box B:** Answer – summarise in 1 or 2 bullet points in Box B1. Then complete Box B2 with a brief but exact answer plan.
3. **Box C:** list the key vocabulary you will use to answer the question (including definitions of terms in question),
4. **Box C:** draw fully and accurately relevant diagram (s), Label expertly showing how any stakeholders are affected.
5. **Box C:** describe a relevant example (real world example required for part b – carefully use any data given to you in the question).

Recommended Pathway: Complete A then B then C then B2 and finally box D
