<u>3 Tasks: Connecting 6 diagrams to economic development + key concepts.</u>

6 Diagrams for Development in 6 Steps

Instructions to be given to group: all 6 diagrams must be discussed in your group discussion

Task A:-Box A (15 -20 minutes)

- 1. To start: Each student should write a brief explanation of economic development. Try and refer to HDI. Also, ask the group what is absolute poverty: (Deficiency of resources to pay for food, shelter + clothing)
- 2. Give students 5 minutes to study **TWO** diagrams that they would use to discuss development and poverty and then ask for any questions.
- 3. Peer Tutor explains each diagram briefly.
- 4. **Assign** each student to draw **ONE** of the 6 diagrams in **BOX A** (page 2) with complete labels. Diagram should be drawn from memory but if not use the hardcopy examples to draw the diagram accurately. Some students may take a second diagram so that all 6 diagrams are covered by the group. Draw diagram large enough for all to see and understand.

Task B-Box B: (10 minutes)

Question: how does each diagram links to *economic development (and/or poverty)*? All 6 diagrams must be discussed.

- 1. Each student should show on their diagram(s) how the diagram connects to economic development. Be sure to try and make a direct connection between the diagram and economic development. Use the terms in BOX B to help you make a connection.
- 2. Each student should then present ONE diagram to the group. Use any of the terms in BOX B (page 2) to help. Show that you understand the diagram by linking exactly to one or two of the development items in BOX B.
- 3. Try and use as many of the 6 diagrams to connect with development as possible.

Task C- Box C: (10 minutes)

Question: how does each diagram link to at least **one key concept** in economics posted below in BOX C?

- 1. Each student should show <u>on their diagram(s)</u> how it connects to the economic key concept. Be sure to try and make a direct/exact connection between the diagram and the key concept. Use the terms in BOX C to help you to make the connection.
- **2.** Each student feeds back to group using ONE diagram to explain the connection.
- 3. Overall the group should try and use as many of the 6 diagrams to connect with the key concepts as possible
